## Graded races:

Graded races are available on the $29^{\text {th }}$ of June. Entry fee $€ 15 / 110$ DKK in class $1-2$ and $€ 10 / 75 \mathrm{DKK}$ in class 3-5.

Entries to graded races close Wednesday evening for dogs eliminated in the semi-finals and Sunday 20:00 for dogs not entered to the CGRC European Championship races.

## Practical information:

Camping at the track is available for free.
Only CGRC approved muzzles that do not affect photo finish are allowed. E.g., Australian and English/Irish type wire muzzles or plastic-coated wire muzzles are allowed, while American type "box" muzzles are not.

All dogs must be present at the track from one hour before first race to 15 minutes after last race.

Races start at 18:00 CEST on Wednesday and 14:00 CEST on Saturday.

## Additional information:

The CGRC European Championship is open to dogs of all nationalities but the dog must have a valid CGRC or FCI approved racing license.
*In case of 7 entries, two semi-finals will still be held with the first 3 dogs from each semi-final going through to the final.
